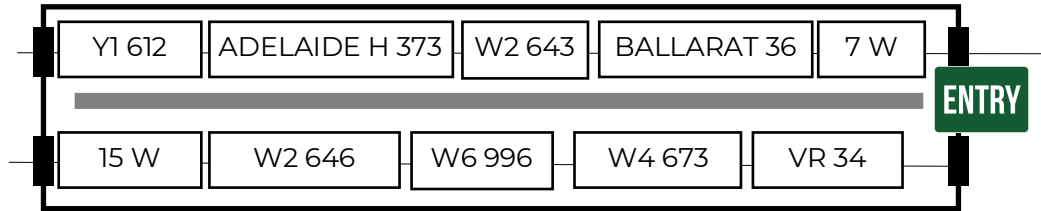

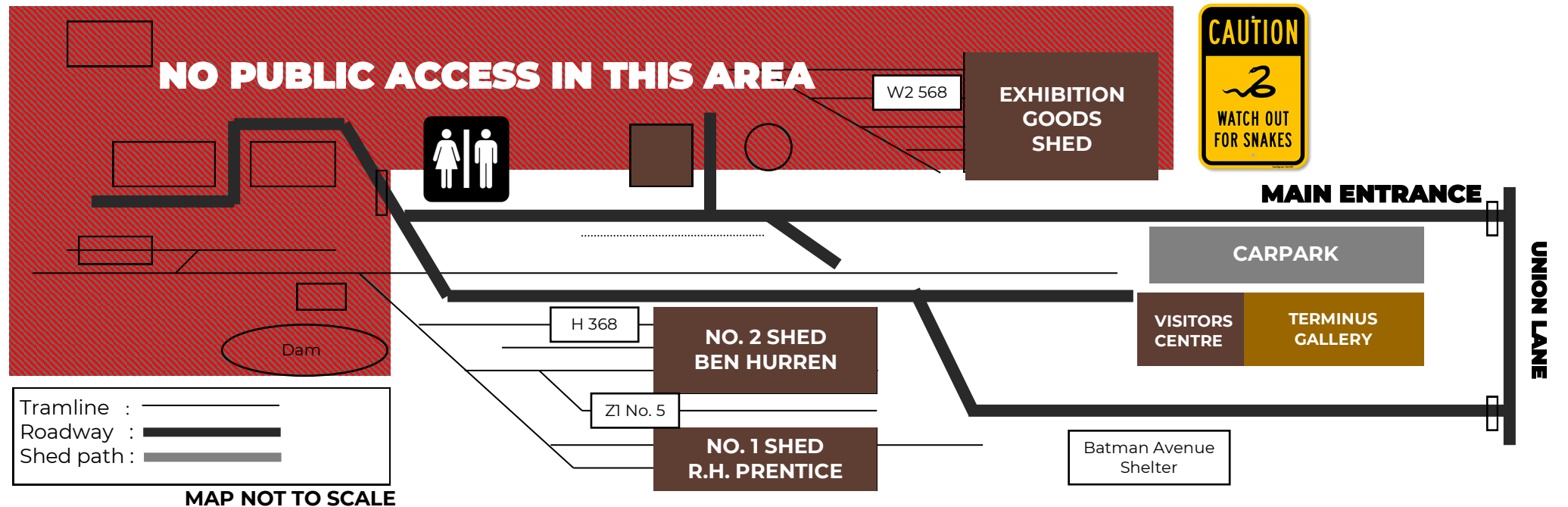
WELCOME TO THE TRAMWAY HERITAGE CENTRE

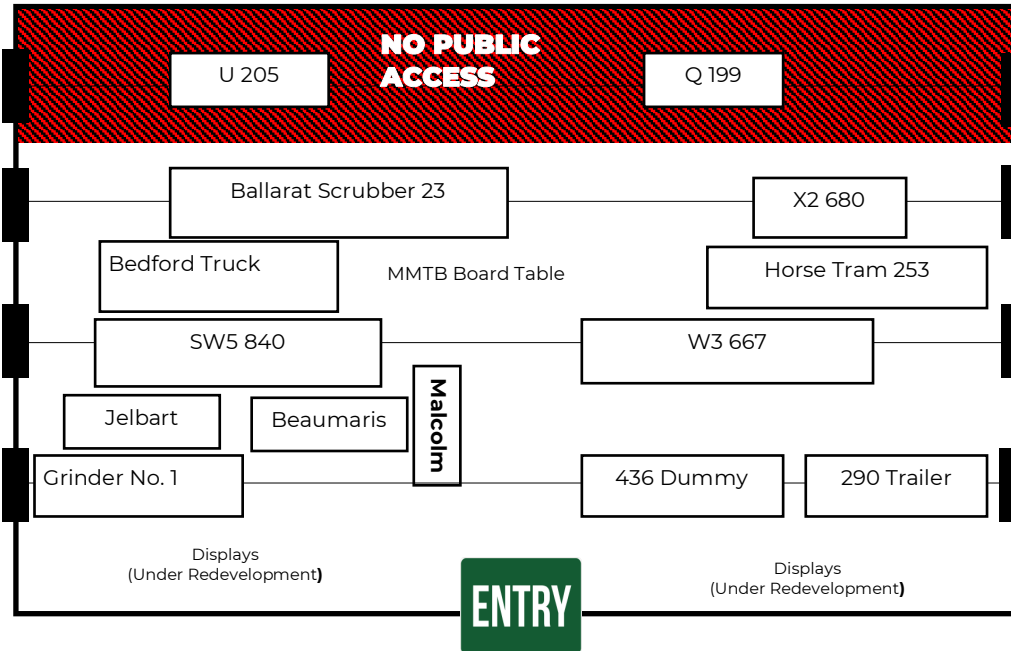

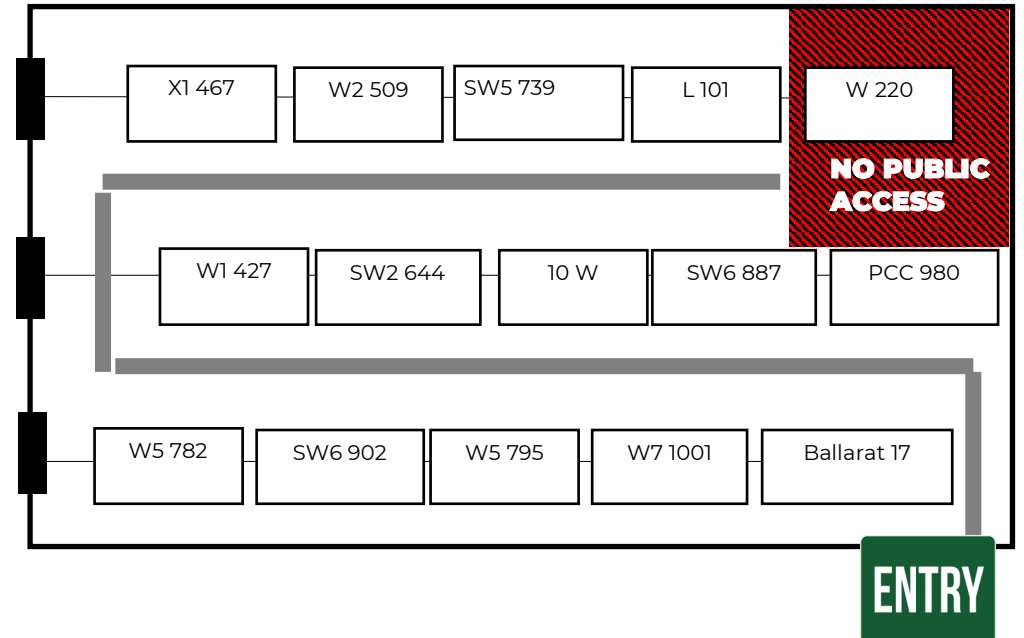
EXHIBITION GOODS SHED
